



C is for Cannonball hole. In the back of the Old Stone Fort, high on the wall just below the roof, there is a cannonball hole. During the American Revolution, the fort was attacked on October 17, 1780 by a British army led by Sir John Johnson. In the fight, Johnson ordered his small cannon to be fired at the fort. One ball went through the roof and lodged in a rafter on the other side. Another made the hole that is visible today. The cannonball that made it and the block of wood it landed in, can be seen inside the museum!
