H is for Hartmann's Dorf House.

The early German settlers of the Schoharie Valley built simple wood-frame farmhouses such as the Hartmann's Dorf house on the museum grounds. This house once stood between the present-day villages of Schoharie and Middleburgh at a place that was called Hartmann's Dorf in colonial times. A dorf was German for "village". Hartmann's Dorf was named after the leading man of the village, Hartmann Windecker.
