museum has many documents that were written with ink and a feather, or quill, pen. There are land deeds and letters on exhibit and more are found in the Library and Archives. Many of these documents are older than the Old Stone Fort! Not everyone could read and write in colonial times, so some signed their name with an X. Native Americans sometimes drew their clan, or family, symbols, which were animals, instead of signing deeds.
