R is for Rambler. The oldest

automobile in Schoharie County is in the museum collection! It is a 1903 Rambler that was owned by Mr. and Mrs. Perry E. Taylor. This "horseless carriage" was considered a strange sight when Mr. Taylor first drove it into the county. Imagine what people thought when Mrs. Taylor drove it! Women just didn't do that sort of thing back then! Mrs. Taylor was one of the first women in New York State to be issued a driving license and she later became the first woman mayor in the state.
