S is for Schoolhouse. The Oliver

Schoolhouse was built in Charlotteville in 1863. All the students from Summit District #3 went to this school, which only had ONE room and ONE teacher for all the grades. The only heat was a wood stove that the children would have to keep putting wood inside to keep the fire going. Sorry, there wasn't any air conditioning when it was hot! Did you know that students didn't have notebooks then? They used small chalkboards called slates and wrote on them with chalk.
